To date, Eli has taught hundreds of students and has been instrumental in promoting this art. In 2003, Eli was been invited to the Woodturning Center, Philadelphia, as an ITE participant. ITE (International Turning Exchange) is a prestigious International event, bringing together every year a small group of carefully selected Wood Masters to share their knowledge and creativity. Eli is one of the leading wood art masters in wood turning and his creations are displayed in many exhibitions both locally and around the world


