COMING IN JULY ELI EVISERA

Since then, Eli is a professional woodworker. Eli is an international woodturning demonstrator and teacher. Eli has been invited to many countries to show his unique variety of techniques. Eli uses a line of his own signature tools (manufactured by Hamlet Tools). These unique tools have been developed based on over 30 years of experience in woodturning. In 1988 Eli established the "Wood Craft Center" where he teaches workshops for furniture building, wood turning and wood carving at all skill levels. To date, Eli has taught hundreds of students and has been instrumental in promoting this art. In 2003, Eli was been invited to the Woodturning Center, Philadelphia, as an ITE participant. ITE (International Turning Exchange) is a prestigious International event, bringing together every year a small group of carefully selected Wood Masters to share their knowledge and creativity. Eli is one of the leading wood art masters in wood turning and his creations are displayed in many exhibitions both locally and around the world


