N-Z, bring desserts.


Remember to bring serving utensils for the dish you're bringing, and to label your dish and utensils.

From Bremerton/Silverdale go north to Hood Canal Bridge, cross the bridge and go about 8 miles (west) on HWY 104 to Quilcene junction.

Turn right (south, the road loops around to point you in the correct direction) onto Center Road at the junction stop sign. Go about 8 miles (towards Quilcene) and then turn left onto E Quilcene Rd (before the junction with Hwy 101).

Go about 2 miles on E Quilcene Rd and then turn left onto Lindsay Hill Rd. Go about 2.5 miles to arrive at your destination – 2741 Lindsay Hill Road. There will be signs close to the house to guide and help indicate the preferred parking areas.
